- CAMP Summer Intern Project. Road, guardrail, culvert, and sign inventory has begun. Jeremy Wilcox and I attended training with Nick Bertsch.
- This month, I attended Highway School in Ithaca NY, on June 6-8. Topics included standards, maintenance, purchasing, communications, safety, (guardrails & pavement marking), budget, legal and regulatory obligations, CHIP's, tree standards,
- The new "Fuelmaster" fuel delivery system discussions and fact finding are presently open.
- Williamson Law Book Co. software is up and running.
- I have been exploring options in solar energy for the Town.
- Plan to remove propane/install gas soon. (weather dependent)
- CHIPS – Still waiting on any increase – should be proportional to Winter Recovery in past. 5/10 UPDATE – PAVE NY share for Town scheduled to be 22,000.00+. UPDATE – "Release is imminent!"
- Byer Road. Work completed, except for guardrail. Waiting for delivery of new, (reused) materials. UPDATE – Expected this week.
- Rathburn Road bridge, work needed, yellow flagged by NYSDOT. Will be attending a seminar on culvert repair from inside in Watertown this month
- NYSDOT, State Route 104 project. Meeting w/ Contractor Wednesday
- Sleepy Hollow Sewer District –Insulation has been completed. Work to begin on bed cleaning Tuesday. Road Improvements possible.
- Spring work – brush pick-up, lawn restoration, ditch cleaning.
- Parkhurst Road – new base complete, topcoat to be applied tomorrow.
- Remainder of paving work to be started around the 4th week of July
