

December 2016 Supervisor's report

It was only about three weeks ago, that we met and passed the 2017 Town Budget (on Nov 18,2016) and then had a break for Thanksgiving. Yet it has been a very busy period in the Town. A lot of the activity revolved around efforts to get all the information and procedures required for the Lakeside Commons project to move forward through the Town Planning Board's process. The review of that process and information has also lead to the Town reviewing the status and facilities of the Ontario Heights Sewer District. I feel that with the assistance of our Town Highway Superintendent and our Town engineer we have a better understanding of the current system and its strength's and weakness. This will enable to Town to move forward with other developments in the further and hopefully lead to some economic growth within our Town.

Another recent significant development has been that we have replaced the Senior Account position with a part-time bookkeeper and a part-time Clerk to the Supervisor. Hopefully filling this positions will fill some gaps in service provided and insure timely reporting and other functions.

We were really pleased to learn that the Town was awarded a grant from NYS for up to \$25,000.00 To complete a Sewer Feasibility study for the Route 104 Commercial corridaor.
