

## March 2017 Supervisor's report

One new development was a letter from the NYS Comptroller's office notifying the Town that we would be undergoing an audit for the period of January 1, 2016 to present. We haven't been notified as to when this would be scheduled. The information will be passed on as soon as it is available.

Looking at the weather outside, it is hard to remember that we are close to spring. One activity in spring is the annual Earth Day, this year being on April 22, 2017. In the past, the Town has provided some assistance to residents who have worked to clean up their neighborhood. Our Highway Superintendent, David Sterio is trying to be more pro-active this year. If residents are planning neighborhood cleanup projects, please contact the Highway department so that they can schedule to pick up bags or other items collected. Additionally, the Highway Department has available high visibility vests, latex gloves and trash bags to enable safer efforts.

There are quite a few ongoing projects in which the Town is involved. Many of these are aimed at reducing expenditures, providing new revenue to the Town or otherwise improving services to the residents. Included on the agenda this month is approval of a change order regarding test borings being taken in preparation for the repair of the bridge on Rathburn Road. We are currently preparing the necessary paperwork and related efforts so that the bridge will be repaired this summer as scheduled.

At the Town Board workshop on February 28, the Town Engineer reviewed progress on many other town projects, such as the feasibility study for commercial sewers on the Route 104 corridor and the Lakeside Commons project. These projects are proceeding smoothly, as are our efforts with the Clean Energy Communities program. Additionally, we are still actively pursuing efforts for the sharing of inter-municipal services. Several local municipalities have had contacts and are examining ways we can work together to reduce the burden to our taxpayers. Hopefully we will have more to report regarding this in the near future.
