Tax Levy Limit Override Local Law for 2017

Dear Rick:

Enclosed please find proposed Local Law No. 1 of 2016 proposing an override of the tax levy limit established in General Municipal Law Section 3-c. Please note that this Local Law must be adopted prior to the adoption of the 2017 Town Budget and is subject to a public hearing on notice of at least five days. The Local Law must be adopted by a 60% majority of the Town Board members present and voting in the affirmative. the Local Law becomes effective upon filing with the New York State Secretary of State. However, I see no harm in adopting the Local Law and at the same meeting, after adoption of the Local Law, adopting the 2017 Town Budget. The budget, of course, does not go into effect until January 1, 2017. The Local Law will be filed immediately after the conclusion of the meeting and on record with the State within one week of its adoption.

#### **SECTION 1 – LEGISLATIVE INTENT:**

It is the intent of this Local Law to override the limit on the amount of real property taxes that may be levied by the Town of Oswego, County of Oswego pursuant to General Municipal Law § 3-c, and to allow the Town of Oswego, County of Oswego to adopt a town budget for (a) town purposes (b) fire protection districts and (c) and other special or improvement district governed by the Town Board for the Fiscal Year 2017 that requires a real property tax levy in excess of the "tax levy limit" as defined by General Municipal Law § 3-c.

#### **SECTION 2 – AUTHORITY:**

This Local Law is adopted pursuant to subdivision 5 of the General Municipal Law § 3-c, which expressly authorizes the Town Board to override the tax levy limit by the adoption of a local law by a vote of sixty percent (60%) of the Town Board.

## SECTION 3 – TAX LEVY LIMIT OVERRIDE:

The Town Board of the Town of Oswego, County of Oswego is hereby authorized to adopt a budget for the Fiscal Year 2017 that requires a real property tax levy in excess of the limited specified in General Municipal Law § 3-c.

## SECTION 4 – SEVERABILITY:

If any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this Local Law or the application thereof to any person, firm or corporation, or circumstance, shall be adjusted by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unconstitutional, such order or judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this Local Law or in its application to the person, individual, firm or corporation or circumstance, directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment or order shall be rendered.

### SECTION 5 - EFFECTIVE DATE:

This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the New York State Department of State.
