

Monthly Report – December 12, 2017, Town of Oswego Highway Department

- Rathburn Road bridge. Met w/ DEC on site to discuss plans. Progress made - we may be able to begin earlier in the summer than previously thought. Found the water main east of the bridge with OCWA last month. Engineer and OCWA will make determination as to relocation and/or adjustment to plans.
- NYSDOT, State Route 104 project. Most work progressing well. Finish paving has been completed. Still working on signs, scheduled to begin tomorrow. Top soil and seeding will be done in the spring of 2018.
- Paving -Maple Ave has been patched for the winter season. Will re-pave in the spring.
- Gravel pit is on tonight's agenda. Winning bidder did not pay.
- Bids for Gas and Diesel supplies received today. Received 2 bids today, bidders did not use specified price index.
- County Plowing Agreement, 1-year pilot program – Fixed rate would have been 5,500.00 more than we received during Jan-April 2017, had program been available at that time.
- Tire Auction – 29.00 bid for 4 used tires.
- Fuel Dispensing bid package – was scheduled for review tonight before distribution to bidders, need to postpone until next meeting.
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- BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS
- Fuel system replacement bid.
- Collected bids for carpet cleaning, lawn care, janitorial services and extermination services for 2018. Bids were opened today at Noon. Will distribute for your review and award at next meeting.
- Septic holding tanks need third pumping this year. April, August, December.
- Jennifer is obtaining info for grant money/reimbursements available through Nat Grid and NYSERDA for heating upgrades to Community Center.
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- SEWER SYSTEMS
- Ontario Heights – working with engineer to ensure new pump station is equipped with all necessary equipment etc.
- Electrical and pump repairs completed at OH after flood. New dialer and hour meters are needed.
