- FEMA Damage Description has been agreed upon. Next step will be estimate of costs to repair and/or mitigate.

- Currently wrapping up tree cutting for the year.
- Currently seeking bids for coveralls, rugs, and paper products for our dept. and a new salt spreader for our ¾ ton pick-up.
