Highway Department

- **Highway**

- Rathburn Road bridge. Met w/ DEC on site to discuss plans. Progress made - we may be able to begin earlier in the summer than previously thought. Found the water main east of the bridge with OCWA last month. Engineer and OCWA will make determination as to relocation and/or adjustment to plans. County Highway is planning to replace both bridges on Co Rt 20 this summer.
- NYSDOT, State Route 104 project. Road signs and mailbox replacement has not been completed. Many issues from residents and mail carrier still not resolved. Top soil and seeding will be done in the spring of 2018. Some additional work has been done.

- Gravel pit to be relisted when weather breaks.
- Cost estimates' have been submitted to FEMA for Lakeshore Rd. and West Lake Rd.
