Monthly Report – June 12, 2018

- **Highway**

- Rathburn Road bridge. Quote for culvert on tonight's agenda.
- NYSDOT, State Route 104 project. Work has been completed. Will be on site next week for replacement of Town's culvert at Thompson Rd intersection.
- Cost estimates' have been submitted to FEMA for Lakeshore Rd. and West Lake Rd. Nothing new at this time.
- BRIDGE NY Application has been submitted. We will be submitting for assistance on the Thompson Rd Bridge, and culverts on Hall Rd, Sabin Rd, Tug Hill Rd, and Ridge Rd, north and south end. Nothing New at this time.
- Brush pick up will now be done daily with a smaller crew, instead of every 2nd and 4th Monday.
- Currently working on replacing culverts, and other drainage issues.
- Shared Services with other Towns and City.
- Verizon Networkfleet provides service alerts, diagnostics, performance calculations, recall alerts, driver performance records inc. speed infractions and idle time, fuel economy and gps location in real time. Also reports highlighting activity in any area.
