

Town of Oswego Highway Department

Monthly Report – March 13, 2018

- **Highway**

- Rathburn Road bridge. Met w/ DEC on site to discuss plans. Progress made - we may be able to begin earlier in the summer than previously thought. Found the water main east of the bridge with OCWA – there is a question as to who is responsible for any work relating to this main. County Highway is planning to replace both bridges on Co Rt 20 this summer. Would like to put materials out for formal bid.
- NYSDOT, State Route 104 project. Road signs and mailbox replacement has not been completed. Many issues from residents and mail carrier still not resolved. Top soil and seeding will be done in the spring of 2018. Some additional work has been done today. Lakeview resident is concerned with intersection. Forwarded to NYS Field Engineer
- Gravel pit to be relisted when weather breaks. Suggest listing in April with review and approval scheduled for the May meeting.
- Cost estimates' have been submitted to FEMA for Lakeshore Rd. and West Lake Rd.
- Tool-Equipment-Material policy – recommendation by auditors.
- Four Employees participated in a training seminar today with Dig-Safely NY.
- BRIDGE NY Application is due this week. We will be submitting for assistance on the Thompson Rd Bridge, and culverts on Hall Rd, Sabin Rd, Tug Hill Rd, and Ridge Rd, north and south end.
- Working with City to bid paving together as 1 contract. 284 agreement should be ready for review next meeting.

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- **BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS**

- Fuel Dispensing bid package on agenda-bid opening March 16, 2:00pm
- Jennifer is obtaining info for grant money/reimbursements available through Nat Grid and NYSERDA for heating upgrades to Community Center.

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- **SEWER SYSTEMS**

- **Ontario Heights**

- Hour meters are still not working.
- Source of excessive water needs to be found and corrected. Other than Homeowner drains and gutters, Rt 104 project and demolition of Diner-Motel should be looked at.
- **Sleepy Hollow** - Bed 3 needed new contactor and overloads. Electrical contractor repaired basic controls so all 3 beds can work. Pump in bed 3 is broken. Beds 1 and 2 are saturated. Camden group will pull bad pump, send 3 to AAI for estimate of rebuild-repair.
