

Monthly Report –November 2016, Town of Oswego Highway Department

- The new “Fuelmaster” fuel delivery system discussions and fact finding are presently open. We have a proposal from Cortland Pump. This should serve as a good beginning for further discussion. Open
- I have been exploring options in solar energy for the Town. We have submitted info to the Central New York Regional Planning and Development Board for their Solarize CNY program. Will keep you informed as info is received. No response at present time. Open
- Natural gas is connected to Highway Facility. Propane tanks scheduled for pick-up.
- Rathburn Road bridge, work needed, RED FLAGGED by NYSDOT. Thompson Road bridge YELLOW FLAGED. Rathburn Rd. will be posted tomorrow, until repaired. Discussing ownership/responsibility of Rathburn Bridge over railroad tracks.
- NYSDOT, State Route 104 project. Both lanes open. Will continue working throughout the month, weather permitting. Work is slower than anticipated, due to changes and existing conditions. Rifenburg will stockpile some millings at Highway Facility over winter months
- Fall work –Last scheduled brush pickup is Monday, the 14th. Trying to catch up on most important ditch/drainage issues before winter. Setting up plows for winter.
- Met w/ Kurt Ospelt, Jim Kelley, Jason Livsey. County will be doing preventive maintenance to catch up. Open.
- Snowplow Grant has been submitted. We submitted grant app, but money was already spent. Rural Development is holding app. For next round – Expect more money in October. No new info
- We received road salt from the County (County road allotment). Mixing in prep for winter.
- The cross has been removed from Comm. Center, with help from Knapp Electric, Auburn, NY. Will replace cap Tuesday, Nov 15, when we replace the arm at street light at Fred Haynes Blvd./Co Rt. 89.
