

Monthly Report – November 14, 2017, Town of Oswego Highway Department

- Rathburn Road bridge. We are still exploring alternate options in order to further reduce costs. Found the water main east of the bridge with OCWA last week. Engineer and OCWA will make determination as to relocation and/or adjustment to plans.
- NYSDOT, State Route 104 project. Most work progressing well. Finish paving has begun. Will continue to pave until told otherwise by State Engineer.
- Paving -Maple Ave may be done in November w/ Rifenberg.
- Gravel pit, Truck 9, other unused parts for disposal through public auction, (Auctions International) are on tonight's agenda.
- NYS DOT performance bond issued 8/14/09 has been renewed (paid) annually – even tho' it was cancelled on 12/16/13. This was discovered this year when I received a copy from Supervisors clerk. Refund for payments dating back to 8/17/14 in the amt. of 550.00.
- Currently picking up brush, there was been a lot since the windstorm 2 weeks ago. Trucks are equipped and ready for winter.
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- BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS
- Fuel system replacement.
- Collecting bids for carpet cleaning, lawn care, janitorial services and extermination services for 2018. Bids due at Noon, 12-12-17.
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- SEWER SYSTEMS
- Ontario Heights – working with engineer to ensure new pump station is equipped with all necessary equipment etc.
- Electrical and pump repairs completed at OH after flood. New dialer is needed. Not sure if pump 2 is running at optimum efficiency.
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
