● Highway

- Rathburn Bridge is open to traffic. We are waiting for the County Crew to assist installation of the guide rail. Thanks to the men for giving so much extra time during August-Sept.
- Cost estimates have been submitted to FEMA for Lakeshore Rd. and West Lake Rd. Engineers report has been sent. FEMA is asking for more detail and photos. They made another field visit on October 4.
- BRIDGE NY Application has been submitted. We will be submitting for assistance on the Thompson Rd Bridge, and culverts on Hall Rd, Sabin Rd, Tug Hill Rd, and Ridge Rd, north and south end. Nothing New at this time.
- Hall Rd culvert at 114 has been paved.
- Brush pick up will now be done daily with a smaller crew, instead of every 2nd and 4th Monday.

- Paving will begin tomorrow on Maple Ave, Lake View Drive, Broadview Drive.
