

Monthly Report – Sept 11, 2017, Town of Oswego Highway Department

- Rathburn Road bridge. We are still exploring alternate options in order to further reduce costs. Plan to find and expose the water main east of the bridge with OCWA to confirm location in October.
- NYSDOT, State Route 104 project. Most work progressing well. If weather stays nice, things will continue to flow smoothly. Cemetery Rd/Co Rt 89 closings to begin 9/18 between 6:00am – 6:00pm. Expected to last 2 weeks.
- Paving -Maple Ave may be done in October w/ Rifengerg.
- Lake levels – Lakeshore road ‘swamp’ still high, road is open. West Lake road pond also high, have been letting water out on a regular basis. Met w/ a rep from Homeland Security to discuss Flooding impact. No new info.
- Gravel pit disposal – recommend Auction w/ Auctions International, at no cost to Town.
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- **BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS**
- Dig Safe request filed for new underground feed to Fred Haynes Blvd street lights. Met with install crew onsite last week. Still waiting.
- Fuel system replacement.
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- **SEWER SYSTEMS**
- Ontario Heights – working with engineer to ensure new pump station is equipped with all necessary equipment etc. Planning to smoke test in October.
- Natural Gas Generator will probably need to be put out for bid. Highway Employees can do natural gas w/ National Grid, could pour concrete pad. Suggest concrete work included as an alternate in bid to determine least expensive option.
