

# **Town of Oswego Highway Department**

## **Monthly Report – September 10, 2019**

- **Highway**

- Thompson Rd bridge has been closed by DOT until further notice. Public meeting, hosted by engineer on June 18 was not well attended. (less than 20)
- FEMA Damage. The town recently received a check from FEMA for their share (75%) of the total estimate. We are still waiting for NY States portion, (12.5% - 25%).
- The Hall Rd culvert has been replaced, and the road has been paved. Frontiers Contractor scheduled to re-bury Fiber within the next 2 weeks.
- Paving is complete on Chapel Rd and Rathburn Rd between Co Rt 20 and 1564 Rathburn Rd. Both roads will be top coated in a few weeks, after they have cured.

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- **BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS**

- **Town Hall**

- One boiler still cuts out at times, Hyde Stone still unsure of reason. No new info at this time.

- **Community Center**

- Electrical work has begun. Rough-in to be completed this week. Will complete finish work after sheetrock is painted. Carpenter will need to be scheduled for sheetrock hang and finish, painting and floor installation. Oswego Mechanical has not started work as of today.

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- **SEWER SYSTEMS**

- **Ontario Heights**

- Need new sewer line turned over to Town. There is a valve that needs yearly maintenance – have yet to locate it. Not sure that Newman has done maintenance.

- **Sleepy Hollow**
