Monthly Report – October 8, 2019

- Highway

- FEMA Damage. The town recently received a check from FEMA for their share (75%) of the total estimate. We are still waiting for NY States portion, (12.5% - 25%).
- The Hall Rd culvert has been replaced, and the road has been paved. Frontiers Contractor has completed their work.
- Paving is scheduled for completion today on Chapel Rd and Rathburn Rd between Co Rt 20 and 1564 Rathburn Rd. All work stayed within budget.
- Beginning to prep and outfit for winter.
- Reminder that all leaves MUST be bagged for pick-up. Please use bio-degradable bags (available at all local hardware stores)

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- BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS

- Town Hall

- One boiler still cuts out at times, Hyde Stone still unsure of reason. No new info at this time.

- Community Center

- Plumbing rough-in has been completed by Oswego Mechanical. Carpenter will need to be scheduled for sheetrock hang and finish, painting and floor installation. Electric and Plumbing trim out to follow.

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- SEWER SYSTEMS

- Ontario Heights

- Need new sewer line turned over to Town. There is a valve that needs yearly maintenance – have yet to locate it. Not sure that Newman has done maintenance.
