TOWN PROJECTS

1. Thompson Road Bridge – Completed and came in under budget. Just a little landscaping and paving remaining to be done by June 1.
2. Lakeshore Sewer Project – Project is progressing and starting construction October, 2021.
3. West Lake and Lakeshore Road projects – We have faced numerous delays and reviewing by permitting authorities, but work is expected to begin this summer.
4. Town Park - Park is now open and swings will be put up by May 1. We are looking for suggestions of what people would like to see added to the park, if funding is available, to make it more enjoyable.
