**Last meeting minutes:**

Barry Pritchard wanted to point a correction that solar panels are located 185 feet east of the house instead of the property. Lee Phillips made a motion to approve the changed May 16, 2022 meeting minutes, second by Mike Dehm. All in favor, no opposition. Motion passed.

**Public Hearing:**

Open at 7:03 PM. Fran gave a background on history of Zoning in the Town of Oswego. He also explained about public hearing procedure.

Sign owners Tony Morgan, Vinnie Morgan and Tim Sheldon discussed the purpose of their sign on State Route 104 and Co Rt 89 to advertise their businesses in the County of Oswego.

Jay Lorenz expressed concern that the signs were billboards and were put up with no permit. No other comments. Chairman Dellamano closed the Public Hearing at 7:10PM.

**Old Business:** none

**New Business:**

Sign permit application submitted by Tim Sheldon for signs currently in place on State Route 104 and Co Rt 89. One sign is for a rental business, the other sign is for a boutique off premises. Kevin Caraccioli has notified the State DOT about the sign due to its proximity to State Route 104 to make a determination. Also, the County Planning Department will need to review Form 239 to make a determination as well as an environmental review. He advised the Board to delay a decision until the State and County have made their determinations. A decision will also have to be made to decide if it's a sign or billboard. Advertising is for business primarily off premises. It was also pointed out that the lettering on the signs were too small to read.

Ernie Mears made a motion to postpone a decision about the signs until the State DOT responds with the inclusion that the sign owners take the signs down, second by Barry Pritchard. The owners will remove the signs on June 21.

Town Supervisor Dan Gurney spoke to remind the Board to complete their NYS Sexual Harassment test and to complete the state mandated training of 4 hours a year.

**Discussion:**

Fran Dellamano asked Dan Gurney to contact Chair Tricia Lorenz regarding Zoning Law Committee.

Fran Dellamano has requested CEO Don LaBarge to look at blinking sign at KTM as it may be illegal.

Judy Sabin Watson has expressed concern on the Rick Eggleston property near Rudys with tractor trailers, backhoes.
