Old Business: *The contract for the Sewer agreement with City of Oswego is being prepared for final approval.
 *Legislator Schadt inquired if the town was going to receive any compensation in return for the use of the Right of Way at the town highway property to be used for the construction of a solar farm on the Simmons property.
 * The Tax Exemption for elderly residents that was passed by the County Legislature in the spring of 2022 was discussed with the board and the assessor and it was decided to revisit this in 2023 and contact towns that did adopt the exemption to determine the impact on the town and all residents. It is the decision of each town as to adopt the County Resolution.
